



PETIT VERDOT 2021

Maule Valley

Vineyards

Vineyards planted over 20 years ago on our La Esperanza Estate in San Rafael in the Maule Valley, 30km from the Andes Mountain Chain. Soils of volcanic origin of varying depth form slopes with differing levels of solar exposure. The climate is Mediterranean with four well-defined seasons and influenced by the evening breezes blowing in from the mountains.

Vinification

The fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks at temperatures of 25°C-28°C and the level of extraction for each batch is decided on a daily basis through tasting by our winemaking team. The malolactic fermentation takes place in stainless steel tanks and a proportion of the wine is then aged in new and used French and American oak barrels for different periods of between 6 months and a year. Then the different batches are blended to obtain wines that achieve a good balance between the fruity aromas typical of the variety, notes of oak and hints of ageing.

Tasting notes

Colour: Intense, deep violet red.

Aroma: Black and red fruit, blackberries, plums, spices, mocha and hints of cedar.

Flavour: Full-bodied with pronounced tannins and a long finish

Red meat and mature cheese. Casseroled poultry, game.

Suggested temperature: 6°C

Alcohol: 13,5 % vol.

Azúcar residual: <4 g / L.

Composición: 100% Petit Verdot
